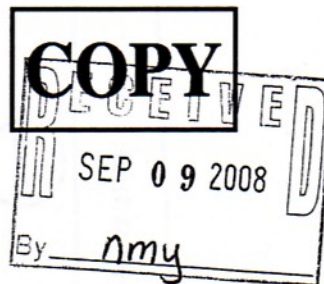

Re: Geothermal lake-loop installation

Dear Sirs,

We hereby request Village Board approval for our application to install a 2" diameter polyethalene pipe loop from the back of the Lyon House down to the lake. The two pipes would be buried approximately four feet below grade. Our application includes copies of the three permits which are required from the State and Federal governments.

Although it would be simplest and least expensive to run staight to the lake, due to our poor relationship with the Hollands, we request permission to run the pipes around their property and through the village property to the lake. A copy of the layout plan is attached.

We would dig a two foot wide trench along the property line on the village side, install the pipes, back fill the trench and plant new grass seed. We will be careful to avoid contact with the village sewer pipe that runs along the lake. The portion of the work located in the village property can be completed in one day.

We received CPP approval last week and would like to proceed with Zoning Board of Appeals for the easement to perform the work.
